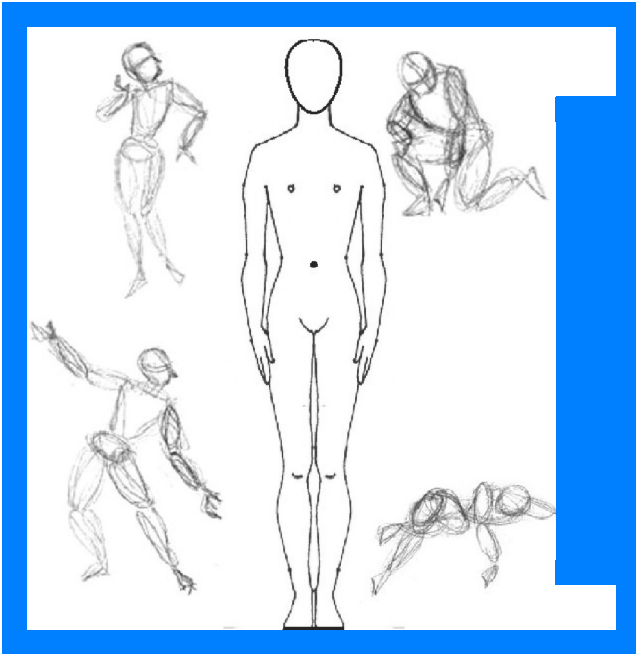


Does your doll seem lifeless?

by Pepper Hume*

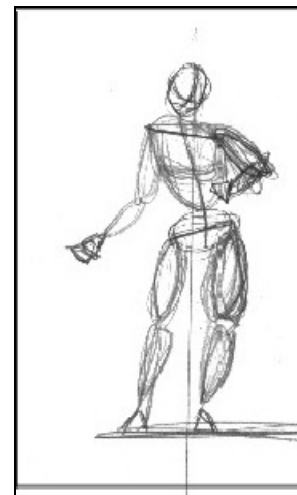
Even with a proper armature, is your doll still awkward and unstable? What happened? It looked so graceful and alive in your head. Perhaps what **didn't** happen is the problem. Maybe you needed to do some ground work on paper before you started the armature.

Pepper Hume shares her technique for giving your doll a natural and believable pose. The most exotic materials required for this 4-week course are a mechanical pencil, a full length mirror and some photographs of people out of magazines. One lesson will deal with proportions of the body and face. Mostly it's easy pencil and paper work with no previous drawing skill required.

She will talk you through the steps of planning a pose and then show you how to develop that plan into the armature for a doll.
